Collaborative Research and Innovation Scheme

In compliance of the directions from NPIU, MHRD, Delhi research proposals are invited research projects form individual faculty member or faculty members from same department of different discipline or different departments. The main objective of the scheme is for enhancement in research output and motivate the faculty members for inter or intra departmental collaborative research.

Expected outcome

The proposal should aim to produce educational and research contents in the form of single or jointly authored publication, book chapters, research monographs, patents, demonstrable technologies and action- oriented research outcomes and product and dissemination in teaching among departments.

Eligibility and Implementation Mechanism:

- a) The proposal should be submitted by individual or two of faculty members (PI & Co-PI) form the same or different departments. The PI must be a regular faculty member of the University departments except departments of Computer Applications (CA) and Architecture. However, the faculty members of these two departments may be considered as Co-PI for joint collaborative research work. Maximum one proposal may be submitted by one faculty member.
- b) Proposals should be submitted in the prescribed format only.
- c) Amount of funding per research project shall not exceed 50,000 (Fifty Thousand). The fund must be utilized only for consumables and minor equipments only. Computer/ laptop and other peripherals are not permissible form this fund.
- d) The fund must be exhausted within 3 months of sanction and the outcome of the proposal may be realized within one year of implementation of the project. The expenditure of the fund will be made as per the TEQIP – III guidelines.
- e) An expert committee duly approved by University will review the proposals received, and select the proposal along with the funding pattern. In addition, the committee will also conduct quarterly review on the progress of the project.
- f) Hard copy of research proposal should be submitted to the Cordinator, TEQIP – III, VSSUT, Burla Office, through the Head of the department of the PI.
