The detailed step-by-step procedure for creating an ABC ID is provided in **Annexure-A1** attached with this notice. Students are advised to retain their ABC ID credentials securely for future academic transactions and verifications.

As per the guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), it is mandatory for all students to possess an ABC ID. All students should complete their ABC registration on or before **27/11/2025**.

□ Important Instructions:

- Students who already possess a valid ABC ID are exempted from this registration process and need to fill up the google form (<https://forms.gle/ajv6UtbwbqxxjAwo6>) so as to update their id to the University.
- Those who have not yet registered must do the registration and fill the google form (<https://forms.gle/ajv6UtbwbqxxjAwo6>).
- **The results of the students who do not have valid ABC id will be withheld and grade sheet will not be issued.**

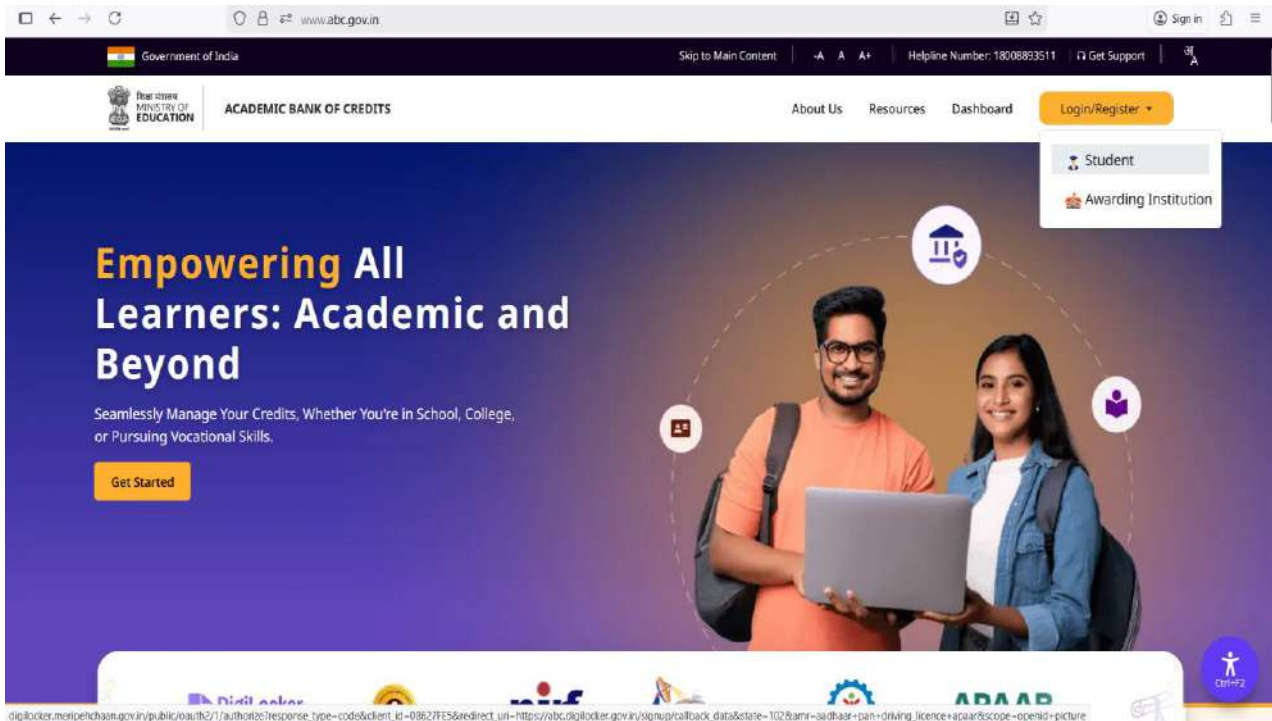

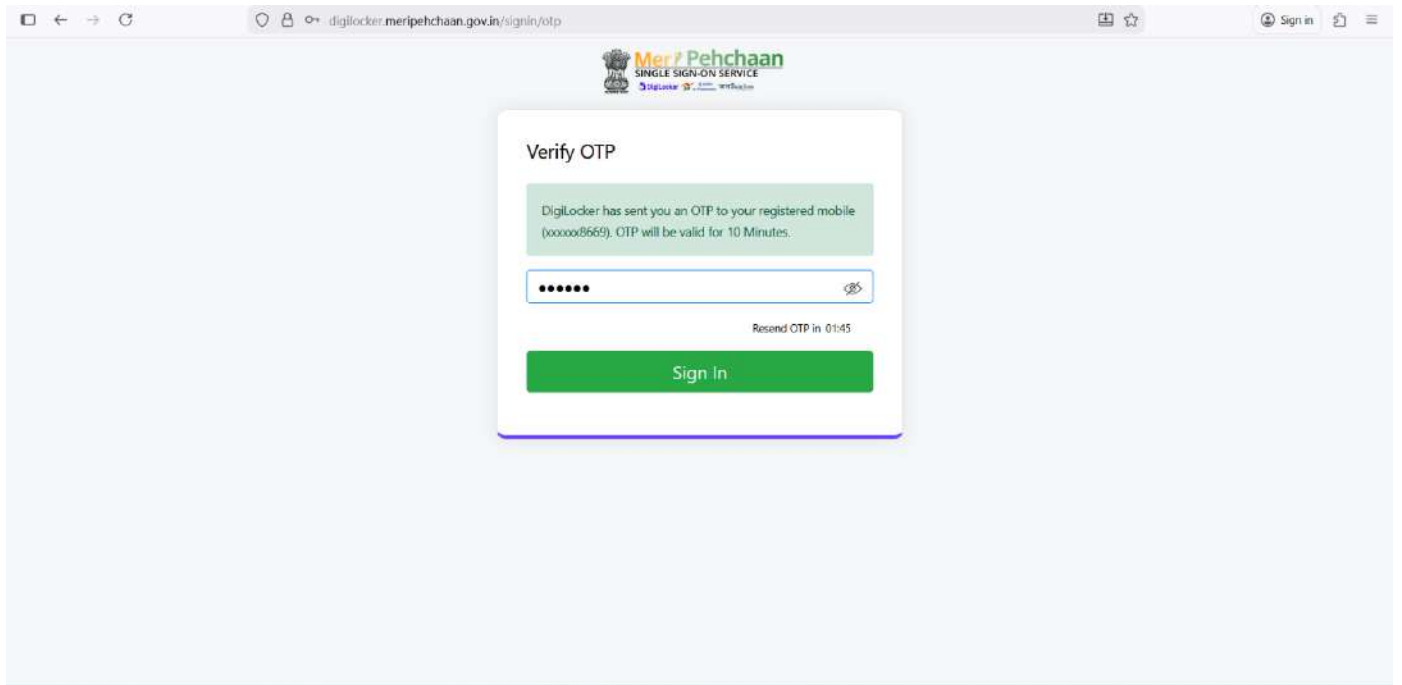

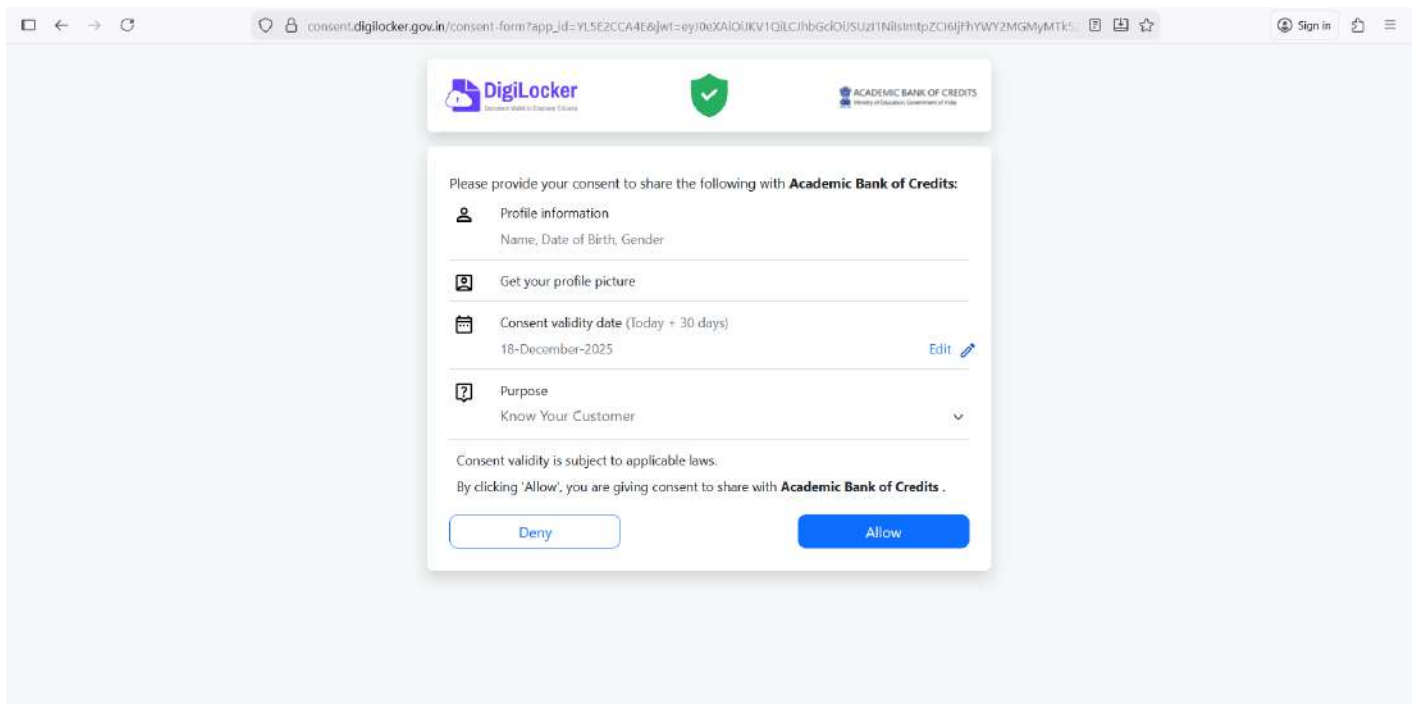

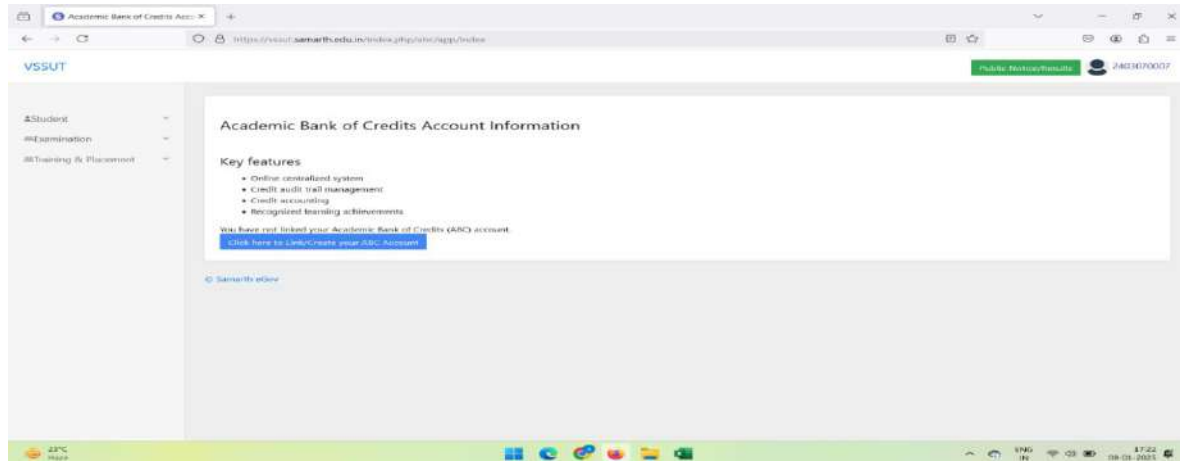

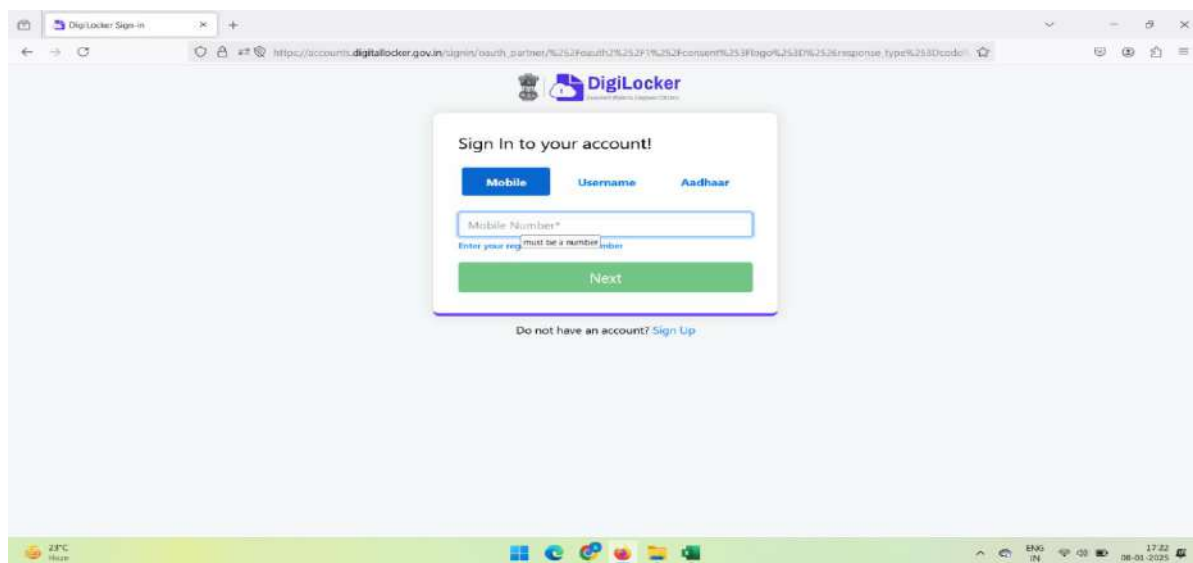

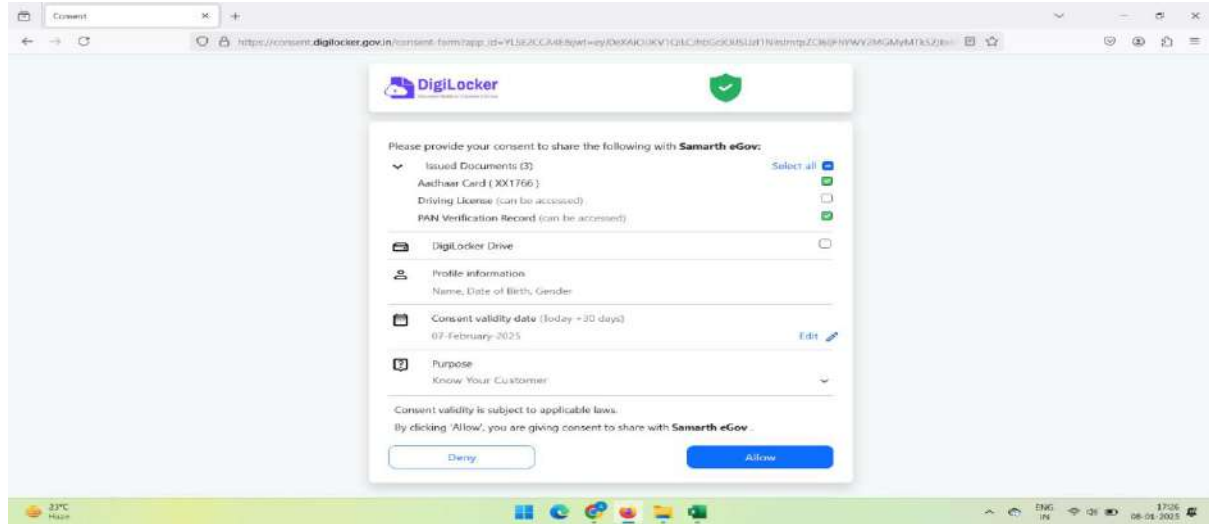
